in backward areas. The Department of Electronics is keeping in constant touch with various State Governments through officers specially designated for this purpose so as to advise and assist in the total planning of the growth of Electronics in the various states as well as in the establishment of individual projects.

LOSS TO LIFE AND PROPERTY DUE TO MULKI TROUBLE IN ANDHRA PRADESH AND MYSORE

PANT): (a) According to the information received from Ihe Government of Andhra Pradesh, 68 persons have been killed in the disturbances connected with the Mulki Rules agitation in the State, so far. The value of loss of property is being ascertained. Information from the Government of Mysore is awaited.

(b) Government are most anxious to bring about an expeditious return to normalcy and satisfactory solutions to the problems agitating the minds of the people of Andhra Pradesh.

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND SUBRA-TECHNOLOGY (SHRI C. MANIAM): (a) and (b) Government's policy in regard to foreign collaboration takes into account the need to avoid repetitive import of technology. This policy is constantly kept under review. The National Committee on Science and Technology and its panels are also engaged in the study of problems of indigenous technological development and its utilisation. One of its panels is currently examining the Governments guidelines for foreign collaboration.

TECHNOLOGY SUBRA-MANIAM): (a) to (c) The term 'agroindustries' covers a very wide range of industries based on agricultural produce or engaged in manufacturing agricultural inputs e.g. textiles, sugar rice milling, handlooms and power-looms, food and fruit processing, agricultural machinery (tractors, power tillers and pumping sets), agricultural implements etc. The industries could be in a cottage, small, medium or large scale sectors. The development of a very large number of agroindustries is the responsibility of the State Governments. In view of the wide range covered and of their wide dispersal throughout the country, information about the names of places where agro-industries have been started in rural areas throughout the country is not available. However, figures of Industrial licences granted for agro-industries in the past few years are enclosed.
