The Cement Corporation of India has also submitted feasibility reports for setting up new units at Baruwala (UP), Neemuch (MP) and Tandur, Yerra-guntla and Adilabad (Andhra Pradesh) with a capacity of 4 lakh tonnes each and at Akaltara (MP) with a capacity of 6 lakh tonnes. These are under consideration of Government.

In order to regulate the distribution of cement equitably some of the State Governments have promulgated suitable regulatory orders. Delhi Administration has also enforced statutory control on cement in July 1972 and introduced "permit system" with effect from the 16th November, 1972 to safeguard the interest of cement consumers in the State. Whenever shortages are reported in a particular region of the country, programmes to rush supplies by rake loads have been arranged in consultation with the Railways. Other steps like opening of dumps at break-of-gauge points, increased road movement by reimbursement of increased freight from the Cement Regulation Account etc. have been encouraged. In order to meet immediate requirement of cement in Delhi, a Special programme of supplies

has been drawn up and a quantity of 10,000 tonnes of cement has already reached Delhi.
