- (a) whether it is a fact that health of powerloom industry workers in the country is deteriorating;
 - (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Government has proposed to give any relief package to workers earning their livelihood from powerloom industry for taking care of their health and upliftment; and
 - (d) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRIMATI PANABAKA LAKSHMI): (a) and (b) No, Sir. Government has not received any representation in this regard.

Decrease in export of clothes and cotton

2480. SHRI NATUJI HALAJI THAKOR: Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it has been estimated that production of cotton thread and cotton clothes will be lower by approximately ten per cent in the country during the current financial year;
 - (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is a fact that there has been decrease in the export of clothes and thread due to higher prices of cotton in the country this year; and
 - (d) if so, the reaction of Government thereto?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRIMATI PANABAKA LAKSHMI): (a) and (b) Production of cotton yarn and cotton cloth in the current financial year (April-September) has risen by 9.1% and 2.9% respectively compared to the corresponding period of 2009-10.

- (c) and (d) The value-wise exports of Cotton Yarn (including thread) during 2010-11 (April-July) has risen by 69.60% over 2009-10 (April-July). The export of apparel/garments is showing a decline of 6.97% during 2010-11 (April-July) over 2009-10 (April-July). Government has put in place the following measures for ensuring cotton security in 2010-11:—
 - (i) exportable surplus of 55 lakh bales identified.
