- (a) whether Government proposes to provide world class facilities particularly to those soldiers who are posted in difficult terrain to contain increasing cases of suicides among soldiers; and
  - (b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI A.K. ANTONY): (a) and (b) A pilot project has been launched for improvement in habitat for troops posted in high altitude areas. Providing appropriate facilities to soldiers posted in difficult terrain is the prime concern of the Government and is an ongoing process. These include not only habitat, but also clothing, rations and other facilities.

## Encroachment on defence land

†2358. SHRIMATI MAYA SINGH: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the defence land is under unauthorized occupation at a large scale in various cities in the country;
  - (b) if so, the State-wise details thereof;

- (d) whether there is any proposal in the favour of poor people who are doing construction work over defence land for years?
