

(b) if so, the details of implementation, State-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT
(SHRI SAUGATA RAY): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) It is proposed in all States. All the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission cities are envisaged to be covered under this scheme to start with, followed by other cities in India. Common Mobility Card (CMC) would be a Smart Card providing for a Common Fare Collection System across different operators (both Government and private) and different modes of public transport as an integrated approach. CMC is envisaged for use across various public transportation systems like buses and metro railways initially and later on will be extended to other modes like trains, ferry etc. as well as parking. The scheme is likely to become operational in 2011-12.

(a) the details of projects submitted by the State Government of Jammu and Kashmir, project-wise and actually approved by his Ministry under the Jawahar Lal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM);

(b) the details of projects submitted by J & K Government under this mission, where technical approval was granted but no funds were released; and

(c) the reasons for not releasing the funds after technical approval?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT
(SHRI SAUGATA RAY): (a) The State Government of Jammu & Kashmir has submitted six projects for consideration for funding under Urban Infrastructure and Governance (UIG) of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM), out of which four projects have been sanctioned with approved cost of Rs. 531.52 crore with Additional Central Assistance (ACA) commitment of Rs. 469.47 crore. So far, Rs. 117.37 crore has been released. Details are given in the Statement-I (*See below*).

Under Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMT) of JNNURM, the State level Sanctioning Committee of State Government of Jammu and Kashmir has recommended 103 projects for consideration for funding, out of which funds have been released for 45 projects having ACA commitment of Rs. 358.81 crore. So far, Rs. 183.54 crore has been released. Details are given in the Statement-II (*See below*).

(b) and (c) Under UIG, one project has been returned to the State Government of Jammu and Kashmir as per detail below:-

The project was technically appraised at total cost of Rs. 38284.00 Lakhs. This project could not be considered due to insufficient amount of allocation left for the State of Jammu and Kashmir.

The State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) of Jammu and Kashmir, in its meeting held on 29.12.2006, recommended 103 projects under UIDSSMT. Of these funds for 45 projects has been released. Out of remaining 58 projects, 27 are on inadmissible components and 19 projects are yet to be technically cleared for want of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs)/modified DPRs from the State. 12 projects are technically cleared out of which Water Supply Project at Baramullah has subsequently been dropped by the State Government and remaining 11 technically cleared projects could not be considered due to insufficient amount of allocation for the State of Jammu and Kashmir. Details of the projects which are technically cleared but for which funds have not been released are given in the Statement-III.
