

NRC against which 19500 applications were received in Chayagaon revenue Circle (Kamraup District) and 15669 applications were received in Barpeta Revenue Circle (Barpeta District). The Government of Assam has set up a Cabinet sub-Committee to examine the difficulties being faced in the process for updation of NRC and to make recommendations for making the process simple and convenient. The State Cabinet Sub-Committee held discussions with the concerned organizations in November, 2010 in this regard. The Government of Assam has been advised that report of the Cabinet Sub-Committee be expedited and timelines for completion of pilot project be suggested.

#### **Terrorism and insurgency in tribal areas**

3171. SHRI TARUN VIJAY: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is aware of the large scale spread of terrorism and insurgency activities in the tribal areas; and

(b) if so, the State-wise details of such activities with the names of organisations involved in such incidences of violence and insurgency?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI AJAY MAKEN):

(a) As per the available inputs, the intense activities of LWE groups are mainly reported from the tribal belts of Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Orissa, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and West Bengal.

(b) Details of LWE violence are given in Statement-I (See below). Details of violence in North Eastern States during the last 2 years is given in Statement-II.
