THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI M.M. PALLAM RAJU): (a) No, Sir.

- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) Around 69% of the material used in manufacture of Advanced Light Helicopter (ALH) is procured from foreign sources. In terms of number of components involved, around 90% of the components are made in India.
- (d) The development and production of ALH has benefited the country immensely by providing a versatile domestic helicopter and enhancing our knowledge base in designing, developing and manufacturing a rotary wing aircraft of this category.

Separate Pay Commission for armed forces

3139. SHRI M.V. MYSURA REDDY: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Supreme Court has directed the Ministry to examine the constitution of separate Pay Commission for armed forces;

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI A.K. ANTONY): (a) to (c) No, Sir. However, Government has taken a decision to set up a separate Pay Commission for Armed Forces in future.

(d) Due to various administrative, financial and legal implications, it has not been found feasible to consider the demand of One Rank One Pension (OROP) fully.
