3403. SHRI RAMA CHANDRA KHUNTIA: Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is aware of the concern of the people on dire need for adequate space for children and young people to play especially in big metropolitan cities;
- (b) if so, the average space available for children to play in the four largest metro cities of the country; and
- (c) the steps taken by Government to set up a National Playing Fields Association in order to ensure exclusive playing space for kids?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI PRATIK PRAKASHBAPU PATIL): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) No specific data is available with the Ministry in this regard.
- (c) The Ministry has set up the "National Playing Fields Association of India" in February, 2009 as a Society under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 with the main objective of protecting, promoting, developing and improving playfields and open spaces for sports and physical recreation. The Ministry has requested State Governments also to set up similar bodies at the States level.

Amount spent on air travel during CWG
