Negotiation with Maoists for peace

- 239. SHRI N.K. SINGH: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
- (a) the total number of districts currently affected by maoists insurgency;
- (b) the number of policemen who lost their lives while fighting insurgents since January, 2010;
- (c) whether the maoists have withdrawn from any district till now where they were active previously in the last one year;
- (d) whether Government is negotiating with the maoists for peace at any level presently; and
 - (e) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI AJAY MAKEN): (a) In 2010 so far, naxal violence has been reported from 90 districts in the country.

- (b) In 2010 (till 31at October), 264 security personnel sacrificed their lives.
- (c) Withdrawal of Maoists from any district has not been noticed during the past one year.
- (d) and (e) The Government has given a call to Left Wing Extremists to abjure violence and come for talks.
