 - (d) if so, the details thereof;
 - (e) whether there is any provision of enquiry; and
 - (f) if so, the details thereof?

- (c) to (f) Yes, Sir. There is a provision for enquiry into each complaint and appropriate action like counselling, warning, fine and termination of contract etc. are taken by the railways, according to the gravity of the offence, only if the complaint is substantiated.
