THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI E. AHAMMED): (a) to (c) No, Sir. The linen provided in the AC accommodation in trains is procured departmentally. Washing and Distribution of linen to the passengers is a mix of departmental and contractual arrangements. With a view to improve upon the quality of washing of linen, Railways have already taken up the project of setting up of mechanized laundries in major coaching terminals. Inspections/Checks are carried out at various levels to monitor the quality of linen supplied to the passengers in trains and punitive action is taken wherever warranted.

Performance analysis of railways by Planning Commission

1203. SHRI R.C. SINGH: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that as per analysis of performance of Railways made by the Planning Commission, Railways is not changing itself with the time;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that the Commission was critique of poor investment track record of the Railways; and
 - (c) if so, the reasons therefor and how Railways is thinking to come out of this?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI E. AHAMMED): (a) and (b) No, Sir.

- (b) whether it is a fact that the percentage of Tribal population in North Frontier Railways is higher than the National Average Population; and
 - (c) if so, the status of population figure and reservation percentage?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI E. AHAMMED): (a) The percentage of reservation in Group $'\in'$ and 'D' direct recruitment posts in all Zonal Railways is 15% for SCs, 7.5% for STs and 27% for OBCs as prescribed by the Government.
