

**Upgradation of Khajuraho Airport in M.P.**

†1411. SHRI RAGHUNANDAN SHARMA : Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is considering a plan to upgrade Khajuraho Airport to international standard;

(b) if so, whether it is a fact that the State Government has provided land to National Airport Authority free of cost for this purposes; and

(c) if so, the details of action taken by Government as regards that land?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Yes, Sir. The State Government of Madhya Pradesh has provided 376.09 acres of land free of cost at Khajuraho airport to provide better infrastructure and international standards of passenger facilities at this airport like extension of runway of 7500 ft. for B 737-800/AB-320 type of aircraft, construction of apron, link taxi track and installation of CAT-I approach lighting system on runway 19 side and are in use. Work related to construction of New Terminal Building to cater 500 passengers and car park have also been initiated with expected date of completion by June, 2011.
