**Schools run as part of NCLP in Gujarat**

1652. SHRI BHARATSINH PRABHATSINH PARMAR: Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the number of schools being run as part of the National Child Labour Project (NCLP) in Gujarat, district-wise, particularly in Rajkot, Bharuch Mehsana, Surat and Vadodara;

(b) the places where these schools are located in the tribal prone districts;

(c) whether Government is aware that many schools have been closed due to lack of funds in Gujarat; and

(d) the details of steps initiated by Government to reopen these schools?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI HARISH RAWAT): (a) The National Child Labour Project (NCLP) Scheme is being implemented in 9 districts of Gujarat State. District-wise details of schools operational are given in the Statement (See below). Bharuch and Mehsana districts are not identified for implementation of the scheme.

(b) The NCLP schools are located in tribal area of Panchmahal and Dahod districts.

(c) The State Government has reported that schools in the Vadodara district have been closed due to lack of release of grant from Ministry of Labour and Employment.

(d) Under the scheme of NCLP, grants are released to the Project Societies subject to the timely submission of requisite documents/information such as QPRs, Audited Accounts, proper Utilisation Certificate etc. However, an amount of Rs. 1662900/- has already been released during 2010-11 to the NCLP, Vadodara as first installment.
