### Ship breaking industry at Alang

2015. SHRI MANGALA KISAN: Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any effort has been made by Government to make ship breaking industry of Alang as eco-friendly with the Japanese cooperation;
- (b) if so, the details and outcome thereof; and
- (c) the time by when Alang is likely to be converted into modern recycling yard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL (SHRI A. SAI PRATHAP): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) Gujarat Maritime Board (GMB) has informed that they are in the process of preparing a Detailed Project Report (DPR) for Environmentally Sound Ship Recycling Project in Alang/Sosiya for seeking Official Development Assistance (ODA) under Japanese International Cooperation Agency (JICA). As the project is at conceptual stage, it is somewhat difficult to indicate time limit for completion of the project. Gujarat Maritime Board has reported that the Alang Ship Recycling Yard has a dedicated Safety Training and Welfare Institute; state of art Hazardous Waste Management Facility; tie up with Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB)/Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC) for management of Radioactive wastes, individual asbestos waste management in many plots and also common mobile asbestos removal facility and hospital facilities.
