STATEMENT

(a) Jute mills are mainly located in the State of West Bengal. There are also a few jute mills located in the States of Andhra Pradesh. Bihar, Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh. There have been load sheddings and interruptions in supply in the We^t Bengal area during the first half of 1972, and restrictions on power supply during peak hours to the extent of 10-15 per cent. So far as jute mills in Uttar Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh are concerned, these States are suffering from power shortage at pre- I sent in view of. the unprecedented poor rainfall this year. There is a cut of 7 2% I on power consumption in jute mills from April. 1972 in Andhra Pradesh and 25% from August. 1972 in Uttar Pradesh. In Bihar and Madhya Pradesh, there have been no power cuts imposed on industries.

It is possible that there might have been loss of production in the jute industry on account of load shedding and power cuts. It will however, not be possible to assess the financial loss on account of this as this could be due to so many other causes.

(b) West Bengal Government have imposed restrictions during peak hours for ensuring rational distribution of the available power. This has resulted in considerable improvement as the frequency of load shedding has been reduced. Further, the power supply to Calcutta region is being stepped up by improving the utilisation of the available generating capacity in the Eastern Region by supply of better fuel and minimising outages of plants which were causing interruptions to power supply. Simii&r steps are being taken in other States as well. Further the projects under onstruction are being expedited so as to give early benefits.l
