beginning in January 1(173, with tlie help of a self-propelled, self-elevating, mobile drilling platform which was being construct-ed in Japan. This platform is expected to be delivered in Japan during this month and to reach Bombay in the next month.

ONGC also plan to continue offshore seismic surveys in the coming years in order to cover Ihe various prospective areas in the Continental Shelf of the country. In case these surveys lead to the discovery of other favourable structures, the testing of those through drilling operations would be considered at the appropriate time.
