

slogans against the Delhi Police. The demonstrating students entered the reporting room and damaged the furniture, telephone and gave a lathi blow to Sub-Inspector Ha wa Singh, duty officer causing injury on his left arm. Addl. District Magistrate and Superintendent of Police (North) and SDM Sadar Bazar reached the police station and tried to pacify the students. The students left the reporting room and gathered in front of it demanding the resignation of the Station House Officer. Attempts to pacify them failed. The demonstrators again became violent and stoned the office of the Station House Officer and other rooms of the police station and broke the glass of the doors. The camera of the Govt, photographer was snatched by the students and was broken. At about 2.30 P.M. the students dispersed after having a talk with the Superintendent of Police, North District.

Earlier to this incident, some students had come to the police station and had asked the sentry on duty to allow them to see an accused in the lock up of the police station which was legitimately refused by the sentry. It appears that the students were infuriated by this refusal and had organised this demonstration.

(a) whether it is a fact that *the* State of Haryana and Punjab have revived the Chandigarh issue and the present and the ex-Chief Minister of Punjab have both denied having accepted Centre's decision on Chandigarh announced in January, 1970 and also made certain new proposals; and

(b) if so, the reaction of Government with regard thereto?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI F.H. MOHSIN): (a) and (b) The Central Government's decision on the future of Chandigarh was announced on the 29th January, 1970 and was conveyed to the Governments of Punjab and Haryana soon thereafter. No communication has been received from either of them suggesting a modification of the Government's decision on Chandigarh.

**PAPER-MACHINERY MANUFACTURERS**

Will the Minister of INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state :

(a) whether the paper machinery manufacturers have informed Government that a large part of their installed capacity has been rendered idle due to lack of supply orders; and

(b) if so, what steps are being taken by Government to ensure full utilisation of the existing capacity in the industry?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT (PROF. SIDDHESHWAR PRASAD):

(a) Some manufacturers of paper machinery have complained of imminent absence of orders.

(b) Import of paper machinery is not allowed in respect of items which are available indigenously subject to reasonable delivery schedules and prices. Parties who are given fresh additional capacities for paper are asked to procure machinery from indigenous paper machinery manufacturers. Coordination between needs of paper machinery and indigenous capabilities is sought to be forged through a representative high level committee.
