(b) what precise role is contemplated to be assigned to joint sector for industrial development under the 5th Five Year Plan?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM) : Government's policy

in regard to the joint sector is derived from the Industrial Policy Resolution of 1956. Participation of the State with private enterprise, whenever required in the national interests, will be subject to an effective voice for Government in the policy and operations of such undertakings. The precise role for the joint sector in the Fifth Plan will have to evolve in the light of Fifth Plan priorities and other relevant factors.

STATEMENT

(a) The memorandum itself contains a summary of the points made in it. A copy of the summary is enclosed. [See Appendix LXXXII, Annexure No. 27]

(b) and (c) The policies of the Govt, for bringing about rapid industrial growth in the country are kept under constant review. Various suggestions, such as those in the Memorandum, are also put forward before the Government from time to time. While all suggestions are taken note of by Government, their policy will be guided by the need for ensuring speedy and broad-based industrial growth aided with social justice.

RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED ON INDUSTRIES

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the statement of West Bengal Chief Minister that one of the constraints to proper implementation of the Fourth Plan was the inability of the monopoly houses, three fourths of which were in West Bengal, to expand due to the restrictions stamped down on them by the Monopoly Act;

(b) whether at the National Development Council meeting he advocated the

passing of a legislation to compel monopoly houses to come into the joint sector; and

(c) if to, the reaction of Government thereto?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) The Chief Minister, West Bengal, has referred to the problem of monopoly houses as having a special reference to industrial development in West Bengal.

(b) The Chief Minister, West Bengal made a passing reference to the problem, in the meeting of the National Development Council held in May, 1972.

(c) Government's overall policy will be governed by the need for promoting industrial growth consistent with our socioeconomic objectives including the prevention of concentration of economic power.
