Dr. J. P. Aggarwal, three other scientists-Dr. R. H. Bhawalkar, Shri S. L. Juneja and Dr. P. K. Ghosh started work on phosphor for Cathode Ray tubes. Some success was achieved by 1968. Dr. Aggarwal resigned in September, 1969 and left for U.S.A. Thereafter a new team of three Scientists of National Physical Laboratory (NPL)-Dr. P. K. Ghosh (Project Leader), Shri H. P. Narang and Shri R. K. Kapoor started a new project to develop a range of phosphors from indigenous raw materials for Television Tubes and other purposes and achieved high spectral efficiency in 1972. The patent has not yet been written by the Scientists and hence no patent has been applied for.

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) In order to step up the production of Newsprint. Government have approved three schemes in the Private Sector with a total capacity of 164,500 tonnes per annum.

Further, in the Public sector, the capacity of Nepa Mills is being increased from 30,000 tonnes to 75,000 tonnes per annum. A new Newsprint Plant, with

a capacity of 80,000 tonnes per annum is also being set up in Kerala by the Hindustan Paper Corporation.
