REORGANISATION OF DAMODAR VALLEY CORPORATION

(a) and (b) The question of re-organisation of the Damodar Valley Corporation on a functional basis is interlinked with the proposal of Government of Bihar to utilise water from Tilaiya and Konar Dams for irrigation purposes. The latter question was discussed by the Chief Ministers of West Bengal and Bihar at a meeting held in Delhi on the 11th August, 1972.
