### INDUSTRIAL COMPLEX AROUND HALDIA

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\*362. SHRI KALI MUKHERJEE: Will the Minister of INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether an industrial complex is proposed to be set up around Haldia; if so the details of the scheme; and
- (b) the steps so far taken and the progress made in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) and (b) The Government of West Bengal have a proposal to develop Haldia as a large industrial complex. For this purpose the infra-structure around Haldia is expected to be developed at an estimated cost of Rs. 15 crores.

Certain measures for the development of the Haldia region are already under implementation. The Petroleum refinery at Haldia is under construction, Haldia Port is expected to be commissioned by June, 1973. Government has approved the setting up of an integrated fertiliser plant (with soda ash and methanol) in the public sector at Haldia. The question of setting up a shipyard in the Haldia region is under active consideration of Government.

# Loss in industrial production due to floods etc.

1069. SHRI SANAT KUMAR RAHA: Will the Minister of INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state the quantum of loss in production in industrial Sector due to drought and floods in the year 1972 in various States?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOP-MENT (PROF SIDDHESHWAR PRASAD). Reports from State Governments reveal that there has generally been no loss in industrial production directly assessable as pertaining to drought and floods during 1972.

#### SCHEME FOR REDEPLOYMENT

1070. DR. BHAI MAHAVIR: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRDHA): (a) Yes, Sir. The scheme for redeployment of surplus staff provides that the surplus staff, during their stay in the Central Cell, would continue to receive pay and allowances in their previous scales. If necessary, where placements have not been decided upon and some delay is anticipated on this account, special leave may be granted to the surplus personnel, which would be on full pay and allowances and would not be debitable to the normal leavs account. The outside limit for such special leave of an individual shall not exceed the prescribed maximum of 6 months. Every effort will be made to arrange individual placements to match the pay scale of the individual with the pay scale of the recipient post as far as posible.
