f [THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (DR. KARAN SINGH) : (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. Hotels built by Government which offer facilities suitable for tourists in the middle income group are the Ranjit and Lodhi Hotels in New Delhi and Railway Hotels at Puri, Ranchi and Aurangabad. Supplementary accommodation

is also available at Travellers' Lodges operated by the India Tourism Development Corporation are Bharatpur, Bhubaneswar, Bijapur, Bodhgaya, Hassan, Khajuraho, Konark, Kovalam, Kulu, Kushinagar, Madurai, Mandu, Sanchi, Tanjore, Trichurapalli and Udaipur. The Department of Tourism has recently completed a Youth Hostel at Jaipur for the low income group.

(c) and (d) The Department of Tourism and the India Tourism Development Corporation have plans to construct additional accommodation for middle and low income group tourists during the Fifth Five Year Plan period. The locations are yet to be finalised.]
