**RE. EXPORT OF STEEL PRODUCED OUT OF  
INDIAN IRON-ORE BY FOREIGN  
COUNTRIES TO INDIA**

513. MISS SAROJ PURUSHOTTAM  
KHAPARDE : Will the Minister of  
FOREIGN TRADE be pleased to state :

(a) the quantity of iron ore exported  
during the last two years ;

(b) whether Government are aware that  
most of these countries are exporting back  
to India the finished steel made mostly out  
of this ore ; if so, the amount of foreign  
exchange involved in such transactions  
during the above period ; and

(c) whether Government have formula-  
ted any plan to process the same iron ore  
in the country to save foreign exchange ?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE  
MINISTRY OF FOREIGN TRADE (SHRI  
A. C. GEORGE) : (a) India exported  
20,816 million tonnes and 20,880 million  
tonnes of iron ore during the years 1970-71  
and 1971-72 respectively.

(b) Iron ore is used for the manufacture  
of pig iron and mild steel. Import of mild  
steel at present is about one million tonne  
per annum which would require less than  
two million tonnes of iron ore. Steel pro-  
ducing countries import iron ore from  
various sources and it is not possible to say  
whether mild steel imported is produced  
from Indian iron ore.

(c) Even after the achievement of self  
sufficiency in steel production, India will  
continue to export iron ore for earning  
foreign exchange since there are vast de-  
posits of iron ore in the country.
