THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE) : (a) No, Sir. The West Bengal Government only approached the Food Corporation of India for supply of maize and for building up stocks of pulses in case the prices went up.

(b I The corporation has agreed to deliver 1498 tonnes of maize, as desired by the State Government. The proposal for stocking of pulses in West Bengal by the Food Corporation did not materialise.
