GROSS NATIONAL PRODUCT

681 SHRI SANVI KUMAR RAHA : Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state the percentage of Gross National Product in the public sector in relation to that of private sector and the GNP from industry in relation to Agriculture ?

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRIMATI INDIRA GANDHI) : According to the latest available estimates published by the Central Statistical Organisation, the relative shares of public and private sectors in the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) during 1968-69 were 14.6 and 86.0 per cent respectively. Similar break-up for Gross National Product (GNP) is not readily available. The percentage shares of agriculture (including animal husbandry and ancillary activities) and manufacturing (registered and unregistered sectors taken together) in the GNP were 46.8 and 13.8 per cent respectively in 1968-69 and 46.3 per cent and 14.2 per cent respectively in 1969-70.
