are designed to protecl the region from the j ravages of AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY be flood and to improve the economy of the rural ;irca by providing assured irrigation over extensive areas. An extensive fubewell irrigation scheme lias been put into effect in this area by the Government of Bihar.

(v) One Pilot Intensive Rural Employment project has been taken up in Musahri Block of Muzaffarpui District; the estimated outlay in 1072-73 is Rs 10 lakhs.

Eastern U. P.

- (i) The Government of U. P. have allocated an amount of Rs 220 crorcs for the Plan schemes in operation in Eastern U. P. for the Fourth five Year Plan period as a whole. Annual outlays are being provided within this total Fourth plan allocation from year to year.
- (ii) A smal1 Fanners' Development Agency is in operation in Pratapgarth District. A Small Farmers' and Agricultural Labourers' project has been set tip in Ballia District. A Drought-prone Areas Programme has been taken up in the districts of Banda, Allahabad, Varnasi and Mirzapur.
- (iii),, The districts of Ballia, Banda, Faiza-bad, Ghazipur and Pratapgarh have been selected for concessional finance from public financial institutions for the purpose of accelerating the pace of industrial development. Out of these districts, Ballia has been selected for Central subsidy of 10% of fixed capital investment.

It has since been decided to increase the coverage of the Central Subsidy scheme. The Central Government will give an outright subsidy of 10% of tin; fixed capital investment to industrial units in G selected districts/areas (in place, of 2 districts originally envisaged) in each of the 9 States including Bihar and U. V. identified as industrially backward. Further, the limit of the fixed capital investment for the purpose of Central subsidy will not be restricted to the units having a fixed capital investment of Rs. 50 lakhs only but will also be extended to those units having a fixed capital investment of more than Rs. 50 lakhs subject to the subsidy limit of Rs. 5 lakhs.

MANUFACTURE OF LAMDRETTA SCOOTER IN LUCKNOW

- (d) the reasons for having the project in die joint sector instead of public sector?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN I'HK MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT' (PROF. SIDDHESHWAR PRASAD):

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) The agreement provides for acquisition, for a sum of about Rs. 1.5crores, of the entire scooter manufacturing plant of M/s. Innocenti at Milano, Italy, on "as is where is" condition, together with the drawings, designs and techni cal data for the manufacture of the latest models of Lambretta scooters. A company with an authorised capital of Rs. 10 crores will be incorporated for undertaking the manu facture and sale f-f Lambretta scooters. The Government of India will hold 51% shares of the proposed company, M/s. Innocenti about 20% and the halance 29% of the shares shall

be contributed by M/g, Automobile Produces of India Ltd., and the general public.

- (c) and (d) Government will have 51% shareholding ,'n the proposed company and, therefore, the project will actually be in the public sector. However, Government have de^ cided to associate M/s. Automobile Projects of India Ltd. and M/s. Innocenti in the project for the following reasons:
 - (i) The present proposal has emerged out cf an initial proposal submitted by M/s. Automobile Products of India Ltd. who have been manufacturing Lambretla scooters in collaboration with M/s. Innocenli of Italy for the last 10 years or so, that they should be permitted to purchase the entire manufacturing facilities of the Italian firm on "as is where is" basis and to set up these facilities in India to manufacture 100,000 scooters per annum.
 - (ii) Participation by the Indian firm and the Italian firm will bring to the project the benefit of the experience of both of them in management and production techniques and result in the speedy implementation of the project.
