(c) and (d) Government will have 51% share-holding in the proposed company and, therefore, the project will actually be in the public sector. However, Government have decided to associate M/s. Automobile Projects of India Ltd. and M/s. Innocenti in the project for the following reasons :

(i) The present proposal has emerged out of an initial proposal submitted by M/s. Automobile Products of India Ltd. who have been manufacturing Lambretta scooters in collaboration with M/s. Innocenti of Italy for the last 10 years or so, that they should be permitted to purchase the entire manufacturing facilities of the Italian firm on "as is where is" basis and to set up these facilities in India to manufacture 100,000 scooters per annum.

(ii) Participation by the Indian firm and the Italian firm will bring to the project the benefit of the experience of both of them in management and production techniques and result in the speedy implementation of the project.

APPLICATIONS FOR TELEPHONE CONNECTIONS IN CALCUTTA

724. SHRI KALI MUKHERJEE : Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state :

(a) the number of applications received for new telephone connections in Calcutta from 1st January, 1969 to 30th June, 1972 ;

(b) the number of persons provided with new telephone connections in Calcutta from 1st January, 1969 to 30th June, 1972 ;

(c) the average waiting period for new telephone connections in trading sections and residential areas of Calcutta, respectively ; and

(d) whether it is a fact that experts have estimated that the new national economy growth factors would push up the telephone demand in Calcutta to well over 3 lakhs by the year 1973-74; if so, the action proposed to be taken by the Government to meet such a demand ?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI H. N. BAHUGUNA) : (a) A total number of 27,184 applications were received for new telephone connections in Calcutta from 1st January, 1969 to 30th June, 1972.

(b) 16,073 applicants were provided with new telephone connections during the period ;

(c) The average waiting period of new telephone connections in Trading Sections is 2

years for OYT, 3 years for Special Category and 9 years for General Category. The average-waiting period for residential areas is 1 year for OYT, 2 years for Special Category and 10 years for General Category.

"(d) Based on a Survey in 1969 which was carried out for the Fourth Five Year Plan, the Calcutta Telephones had assessed the anticipated demands in 1973-74 to be about 3 lakhs. However, as per present indications these demands will not come up. There was actually a steep fall in demands of nearly 67,000 during the year 1970-71. Demand has again picked up during 1971-72 and the present growth judged from 1971-72 figures is about

•9,500 per year. The demand as on 31-3-72 was about 1,50,000 and the expected demand in 1973-74 is only about 1,70,000. With the limited equipment available, it is not possible to completely eliminate the waiting list in the

near future. The Government is taking action to increase the capacity of Calcutta Telephones by about 60,000 lines during the next 6 years. In addition, the Government are taking steps to augment production of switching equipment, availability of which alone can solve this problem.
