THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI Y. B. CHAV-VN): (a) and (b) India's foreign exchange reserves including Gold and SDRs were Rs. 846 crores on 1st July, 1972 compared with Rs. 787 crores as on 1st July, 1971. The figure for 1972 includes fresh allocation of SDRs on 1st January, 1972, amounting to Rs. 74.7 crores.

ACCOMMODATION FOR MARRIED MILITARY PERSONNEL

(a) whether it is a fact that Married Officers and other ranks of the Armed Forces entitled to accommodation are not being provided with cent per cent Government accommodation at family stations; and

(b) If so, the details of the steps that Government are taking to mitigate hardship of the married Officers and Jawans?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM): (a) and (b) A Statement is laid on the Table of the Sabha.

STATEMENT

(a) It is a fact that it has not been feasible to provide all entitled Armed Forces personnel, including officers, with Government accommodation at family stations ;

(b) Efforts are being made to make good the deficiencies of Married Accommodation by new constructions. In the meantime, following steps have been taken to mitigate hardship of Officers and Jawans :—

(i) Government have hired private accommodation at selected stations for allotment to Married Officers and other entitled Armed Forces personnel.

(ii) Officers are permitted to hire married accommodation on their own and

to claim reimbursement of the difference between approved rent of the accommodation and the rent that would have been recovered from the officer had he occupied Government accommodation.

(iii) JCOs and ORs of the Army and equivalents in the Navy and Air Force are also allowed to hire Married Accommodation and claim compensation in lieu of quarters.

SOLDIERS DISABLED IN INDO-PAK WAR

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to refer to the reply to Unstarred Question No. 5 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 14th March, 1972 and state the number of soldiers disabled during 1971 Indo-Pak war. how many of them have been rehabilitated and by when the rest (if they will be rehabilitated]

रक्षा मंत्री श्री जगजीवनराम : उन कामियों को जो कि 1971 के भारत-पाक युद्ध में घायल हुए थे,

अभी तक अक्षतताओं के कारण सेवामुक्त नहीं किया गया है क्योंकि या तो उनकी चिकित्सा चल रही है या वे बिमारी के कारण अवकाश पर हैं। वे बंदस्तूर सैनिक सेवा में हैं, और अपने पूरे वेतन तथा भत्ते प्राप्त कर रहे हैं। सेवा मुक्त होने पर उनकी असमर्थता के अनुरूप उन्हें पेंशन दी जायगी। तथापि इसी बीच में उनसे, हरेक से व्यक्तिगत रूप से सम्पर्क करके, उनके पुन-व्यवस्थापन के संबंध में उनकी अक्षतता के अनुरूप उप-युक्त प्रारम्भिक कार्य प्रारम्भ कर दिया गया है। इससे पूर्व कि युद्ध में अक्षत हुए कामिक सेवा करने में असमर्थता के आधार पर सेवा मुक्त हो सरकार उनके पुन-व्यवस्थापन होने में सहायता देने का हरादा रखती है।

[THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM) : The personnel wounded in the 1971 Indo-Pak war have not so far been discharged from service on account of disabilities, since they are still undergoing medical treatment or are on sick leave. They continue to be in military service and draw their full pay and allowances. In the event of their being discharged, they will be granted pensions according to the degree of their disablement. Preparatory work, however, is being done in the meantime by contacting them individually in order to decide the appropriate mode of rehabilitation for each of them, suited to his disability. Government intend to assist in the rehabilitation of the war disabled military personnel before they are invalided out of service.]
