THEFT OF FOOD STUFFS

*488. SHRI KALYAN ROY: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news item published in the Ananda Bazar Patrika dated the 10th June, 1972, under the heading "75 lakhs rupees worth of food stuffs stolen in six months".
- (b) if so, what is the Government's reaction thereto;
- (c) whether Government have fully investigated into these allegations; if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) what steps have been taken against the persons responsible for this?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) to (d) The Food Corporation was asked to report in the matter. The Corporation's report in respect of the allegations of pilferage of foodgrains is as follows:—

Cossipore/Shyamnagar, Kalighat rail yards are under the protection of the Eastern Railways and are properly guarded by them.

The allegation concerning the Shyamnagar siding was referred to the local police who after investigation have reported that there had not been any instance of wagon looting of foodgrains from standing wagons. As regards Kantapukure siding, report of pilferage is not correct as the godown remained closed during the relevant time due to labour trouble and no wagons were received there.

As regards remaining allegations made in the news item further report from the Food Corporation of India, is awaited. On receipt of the complete

report from the F.C.I., action as necessary against persons found guilty would be taken.

BILL TO CHECK AIR POLLUTION

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING (SHRI UMA SHANKAR DIKSHIT): (a) and (b) The draft legislation submitted by the Expert Committee on Air Pollution Control is being processed by Government. It has been referred to the chairman of the National Committee on Environmental Planning and Coordination. It will also have to be circulated to various States for their concurrence since the subject is in the State List and Par-

liament can pass a law in this regard only if two or more State Legislatures pass resolutions under Article 252 of the Constitution. It is, therefore, not possible to indicate precisely the time by which the proposed legislation would be introduced in Parliament although Government is keen to do so at the earliest opportunity.

PRODUCTIVITY OF LAND

*491. SARDAR AMJAD ALI: Will Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state the steps that are being taken by Government for increasing productivity of land?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): A statement is laid on the Table of the Sabha.

STATEMENT

The Indian Council of Agricultural Research have taken up 5 All India Coordinated Project to develop technology for improving productivity of land. In these projects, research efforts are being carried out to develop efficient methods of agronomic practices, tilisers use and maintenance of physical conditions of soil for obtaining higher crop production.

On the development side, efforts are being made to promote fertilisers use in proper balance suited to the needs of soil and the crop alongwith appropriate micro-nutrients and other inputs. To facilitate this, soil testing facilities have been provided and the farmers are given training in efficient and balanced use of development Besides, minor irrigation facilities, intensification of plant protection measures, land development and soil conservation are some of the other measures being undertaken to increase productivity of land.
