VIOLATION OF THE WAGE BOARD AWARD BY
KARNANI NIMCHA COLLIERY

1337. SHRI N. R. KRISHNAN: Will the Minister of LABOUR AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government are aware that the management of the Karnani Nimcha Colliery, near Raniganj, West Bengal has been violating all the terms of the Coal Mines Wage Board and paying much less to the workers; it so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether the certificate of the Regional Labour Commissioner (Central) Asansol issued to the Company has been cancelled; if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF LABOUR AND REHABILITATION (SHRI R.K. KHADIL-KAR). (a) The management of Karnani Nimcha Colliery are not fully implementing the recommendations of the Wage Board. The rates of wages paid to different categories of workmen are lower by 10 to 12% than the rates recommended by the Wage Board.

(b) The implementation certificate issued to the Company has been cancelled by the Regional Labour Commissioner (Central).

(b) Shri J.G. Kumaramangalam has been associated with the Neyveli Lignite Corporation from August, 1967, first as Managing Director and subsequently as Chairman-cum-Managing Director. Α number of problems are facing the Corporation including those of (i) acquisition and installation of additional mining machinery, (ii) replacement of specialised mining machinery, (iii) a proposal to set up a super power station based on a second mine cut Keeping in view his past association with the Neyveli Lignite Corporation and experience it was felt that the advice of Shri J. G. Kumaramangalam should be available to the NLC's Board of Directors.
