(b) It will be seen from the statement referred to above that area under cotton has been fluctuating due mainly

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to prevaling weather conditions major rainfed cotton growing States and diversion of area to more remunerative

THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) There is no special crash programme or other programme for setting up a network for spraying insecticides at block level, in addition to the plant protection work currently being done by the block staff organising ground and aerial spraying operations under the State and Central Schemes.

- (b) The Government of India have broadly estimated the requirements of aircraft necessary for aerial spraying operations over the next few years. Out of this, the number of helicopters that would be necessary, is being worked out on the basis of areas which can be sprayed only by such aircraft.
- (c) No helicopters specially built for agricultural aviation is being manufactured in the country. Government of India are exploring the possibilities of using indigenously produced copters for agricultural aviation purposes.

ALL INDIA COTTON ACREAGE

- (a) whether it is a fact that between 1964-65 to 1970-71 the all India Cotton acreage fell by about 75,000 hectares;

- THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) A statement indicating area under cotton from 1961-62 to 1970-71 is attached. It will be seen therefrom that the area under cotton during 1964-65 was abnormally high.

(c) It is proposed to expand cotton cultivation under irrigation and in the new Projects like Nagarjunasagar, Tungabhadra and Rajasthan Canal area. The acreage under cotton in the above States has already recorded increase. However, in the cotton devedopment programmes the main stress is on increasing productivity per unit area through various intensification measures, rather than increasing the area. cording to the latest reports available. even though the area under cotton during 1971-72 has been almost the same as in 1970-71, the production has gone up appreciably.
