National Census on tractors, pumpsets and other agricultural machinery is conducted after every five years and the Census for 1971 is now proposed to be conducted in April, 1972 and information on the present population and their State-wise distribution would be known after the Census is completed.

संसदीय कार्य तथा नौवहन और परि-वहन मंत्री (श्री राज बहादुर): (क) से (ग) संभवत माननीय सदस्य उत्तर प्रदेश में बरेली से ग्रासाम मे ग्रमीनगांव तक पाइवंवर्ती सडक के निर्माण का उल्लेख कर रहे है। सड़क कार्य मे 270 मील राष्ट्रीय राजमार्ग का भाग तथा 603 मील राज्य राजमार्ग का शामिल है। इनमे से 398 मील उत्तार में, 328 मील बिहार में तथा 89 मील बंगाल में ग्रीर 58 मील म्रासाम मे है जोकि कूल मिलाकर 873 मील है। इनमें से कुल 735 मील 31-12-1971 तक पूरे हो चुके थे। 31-3-1972 को समाप्त होने वाली अवधि की प्रगति रिपोर्ट प्राप्त नहीं हुई है। सड़क कार्यों में लगभग 86 प्रतिशत प्रगति हुई है। उत्तर प्रदेश मे लगभग 70 मील, बिहार में 17 मील जो कि बिखरे हुए छोटे-छोटे खंडों में है, कुल मिलाकर 15 पश्चिम बंगाल में आसाम मे 36 मील का सडक कार्य स्रभी पूरा होना बाकी है।

is referring to the construction of Lateral Road from Bareilly in U P, to Amingaon in Assam The Road work consists of 270 miles of NH portion and 603 miles of State Highways. Of these, 398 miles are in U. P., 328 miles in Bihar and 89 miles in Bangal and 58 miles in Assam, totalling 873 miles Out of this total 735 miles had been completed till 31 12.1971. Progress reports for the period ending 31 3 1972 have not been received. The progress on road works is approximately 86% 70 miles in U P. and 17 miles in Bihar in scattered reaches and short reaches aggregating to 15 miles in West Bengal and 36 miles in Assam remains to be completed.

Out of 23 Major Bridges (5 in U P, 7 in Bihar, 8 in West Bengal and 3 in Assam) provided on the Lateral Road, 21 (5 in U P, 5 in Bihar, 8 in West Bengal and 3 in Assam) have been completed. The remaining 2 bridges (1) Kankai I is likely to be completed by June 1972 and (2) Gandak is likely to be completed by June 1973.

Out of 128 Medium Bridges (32 in U P. 64 in Bihar 3 in West Bengal and 14 in Assam) 116 bridges (26 in U P, 58 in Bihar, 18 in West Bengal and 14 in Assam) have been completed. The work on the remaining bridges is in various stages of progress for completion.

There are in all 151 Minor bridges, (36 in U. P, 29 in Bihar (including 2 overbridges) 40 in West Bengal and 46 in Assam) to be constructed on the Lateral Road. Out of these 149 (36 in U P, 27 in Bihar, 40 in West Bengal and 46 in Assam) have been completed. The work on the remaining two over-bridges in Bihar is to be started by the Railway authorities

The proposal for the construction of the missing link of Lateral Road between Darbhanga and Foibesganj in Bihar is under consideration of the Government]
