Works on all these routes are in different stages of planning and execution. They will be progressively completed in coming years and completed early in the Fifth plan period.

Trunk Automatic Exchanges (TAXs) have also been planned at Ernakulam, Coimbatore and Trivandrum.

Alleppey, Calicut, Coimbatore, Ernakulam, Kottayam, Ooty, Palghat, Quilon, Salem, Tiruppur, Trichur and Trivandrum will be connected to these 3 TAXs. They will be able to dial each other and also Madras Bangalore and Coimbatore. These routes are also likely to be commissioned by fifth plan period.

IMPROVEMENT IN T.V. PROGRAMME
