BROADCASTING (SHRIMATI NANDINI SATPATHY): During the current Five Year Plan period, it is proposed to implement the following schemes to augment the service to Adivasi areas in Bihar and Orissa:

- (i) Upgrading the power of the existing transmitter and the construction of permanent studios in Ranchi.
- (ii) Upgrading the power of the existing transmitters in Cuttack and Jeypore and the construction of permanent studios in Jeypore and Sambalpur.

MADRAS TELEPHONE EXCHANGE

- *263. SHRI S. A. KHAJA MOHIDEEN: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that the present capacity of Telephone Exchange in Madras cannot cope With the increasing demand lotnew telephone connections there; and
- (b) if so, whether Government have made an assessment about the demand for new telephone connections in the state with a view to expanding its capacity?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS (.SHRI H. N. BAHUGUNA) : (a)
Yes Sir. In some exchange areas the demands cannot be met

(b) Yes Sir. Assessment has been made as per individual exchange areas. As on 31-3-72 the total demands of Madras city Telephone system are 57,353 and the equipped capacity is 57,300.

For other places in the State of Tamil Nadu the total demands are 68,399 and the equipped capacity is 77,627. Expansions of about 9,240 lines have been planned at places where the total demands have exceeded the capacities.

SOURCES TO EARN FOREIGN EXCHANGE

*264. SHRI U. K. LAKSHMANA GOWDA: Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state j

(a) the main sources from which Govern ment piopose to earn foreign exchange in the remaining years of the Fourth Five Year Plan to meet the foreign exchange requirements of

the country; and

(b) what concrete steps Government have taken for tapping those sources?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING (SHRI MOHAN DHARIA): (a) and (b) The main source for earning foreign exchange in the remaining years of the Fourth Five Year Plan is expected to merchandise exports. Amongst these, th-" main items include jute manufactures, tea, cotton textiles, engineering goods, iron ore, leather and leather manufactures, cashewkernels, oilcake-, tabacco, spices, coffee, fish and fish products, chemicals and allied products, handicrafts etc.

Among the steps taken, the more important ones are provision ol import replenishment, removal of capacity constraints, priority and larger allocation of scarce raw materials, raiway freight concession., drawback of import and excise duties aiuPother general and specific reliefs. Other steps are in the field of quality control, exploration of foreign markets, generation of export surpluses and special programmes for raising the domestic output or the main commercial crops. The institutional set up for exports has also been strengthened.
