For other places in the State of Tamil Nadu the total demands are 68,399 and the equipped capacity is 77,627 Expansions of about 9,240 lines have been planned at places where the total demands have exceeded the capacities.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING (SHRI MOHAN DHARIA) (1 and (b) The main source for earning foreign exchange in the remaining years of the Fourth Five Year Plan is expected to merchandise exports. Amongst these, the main items include jute manufactures, tea, cotion textiles, engineering goods, iron ore, leather and leather manufactures, cashew kernels, oilcake, tabacco, spices, coffee, fish and fish products, chemicals and allied products, handicipits etc.

Among the steps taken—the more important ones are provision of import replenishment, removal of capacity constraints, priority and larger allocation of scarce raw materials, raiway height concession, drawback of import and excise duties and other general and specific reliefs. Other steps are in the field of quality control, exploration of foreign markets, generation of export surpluses and special programmes for raising the domestic output of the main commercial creps. The institutional set-up-for exports has also been strengthened.
