(a) whether Government are aware that the All-India Insurance Employees' Association threatened to launch an agitation if its demands are not met;

(b) whether the Association has submitted any memorandum to Government enumerating their demands, and

(c) if so, the nature of their demands and the reaction of Government thereto ?

THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI Y. B. CHAVAN): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) No, Sir. However, the ASSCH has submitted its demands to the Life Insurance Corporation.

(c) The demands raised are :

(i) Recognition of the Association and its affiliated units;

(ii) Higher bonus;

(iii) Higher House Rent Allowance;

(iv) Comprehensive non-contributory Medical Scheme,

(v) Free Insurance!

(vi) Leave Travel Concession;

(vii) Reduction in interest on loans for housing;

(viii) 23-; holidays for all building maintenance staff.

The Corporation discussed these demands with representatives of the employees on the 4th and 5th May, 1972. Further discussions are likely to be held next month.
