† [THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE (PROF S NURUL HASAN) (a) and (b) The report of the Education Commission (1964-66), which contains recommendations of the Commission on student participation in the affairs of the Universities is available in the Parliament Library. These recommendations have been endorsed by the University Grants Commission.

This question has been recently considered by the Gajendragadkar Committee in its report on Governance of Universities. A copy of the report is also available in the Parliament Library. The Commission has generally agreed with all the recommendations of the Committee, including those relating to student participation. The Central Government has also accepted these recommendations. Their implementation would require amendment of the Acts of the universities and further action in this regard is to be taken by the State Governments and the Central Government. So far as the Central Government is concerned these recommendations are being taken into account in formulating legislative proposals for the Central Universities.]

SCHOOLS FOR DEAF AND DUMB

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI K S RAMASWAMY) (a) and (b) Education, including the education of the deaf is the primary responsibility of the States. It is for them to set up schools for the deaf. The Department of Social Welfare is, however, developing a National Centre for the Deaf at Hyderabad.

(c) No reliable information regarding the handicapped population is available. It is generally estimated however, that the country may have 15 to 20 lakh deaf persons. No Statewise break up is available. A list of schools for the deaf, maintained by the Union Department of Social Welfare State-wise is attached (see below). Information about the average number of students in schools for the deaf in various States is not readily available.
