## MANUFACTURE OF TELEVISION SETS BY ELECTRONIC CORPORATION OF INDIA

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRONICS (SHRI K. C. PANT): (a) An industrial licence has been issued to M/s. Electronics Corporation of India, in December 1971, for the manufacture of 20,000 Television sets per annum.

(b) The investment required on plant and equipment is Rs. 25 lakhs, with a foreign ex change content of Rs. 6 lakhs.
