(a) the number of applications for grant of industrial licences from individual companies and public sector undertakings from Orissa that are pending with the Ministry of Industrial Development; and

(b) what is the nature of the applications and the projects applied for?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOP-MENT (SHRI GHANSHYAM OZA): (a) Out of the applications received upto 31-12-71, 29 are pending. Of these, 6 relate to 1970 and 23 to 1971.

(b) Out of thj 29 pending applications 16 are for the establishment of new undertakings, 6 for effecting substantial expansion, 5 for new articles and 2 for carrying on business lkeices. These applications are mainly for the manufacture of shoddy yarn, sponge iron, worsted suiting, caustic soda, cement, paper, beer etc.
