(a) whether the Government of India have held any discussions with the Government of Bangla Desh regarding flood control and joint usage of the common river systems of the two countries generally, and the Farraka Project particularly;

(b) if so, the substance of the discussions; and

(c) the steps Government propose to take as the result of these discussions ?

The MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (DR. K. L. RAO) : (a) to (c) A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT

(a) Yes, sir.

(b) and (c) : It has been decided to establish a joint River Commission comprising exports of both countries on a permanent basis to carry out a comprehensive survey of the river systems shared by the two countries, formulate projects concerning both the countries in the fields of flood control and to implement them.

Experts of the two countries shall formulate detailed proposals on and advance flood forecasting, study of flood control and irrigation projects on the major river system and examine the feasibility of linking the power grids of Bangla Desh with the adjoining areas of India so that the water resources of the region can be utilised on an equitable basis of the mutual benefit of the peoples of the two countries.
