THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING, HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING (SHRI **UMASHANKAR** DIKSHIT): (a) to (e) According to the Zonal Development Plan for the D. I. Z. area, it would be possible to accommodate a density of about 150 persons per acre in this area against the present density of about 35 persons per acre. As and when additional funds become available, the existing single-storeyed quarters are being demolished and are being replaced by multi-storeyed flats to accomodate more families. So far, 399 single storey quarters have been demolished for making sites available for construction of new quarters and for providing community facilities and extension to Willingdon Hospital. During the current financial year, 424 quarters in multiistoreyed blocks have been completed and 188 more quarters are under construction.

RISE IN THE PRICE OF COCONUT OIL

- *199. SHRI J. S. TILAK: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is fact that the prices of coconut oil are very high, and that this essential commodity is practically out of reach of the common man;

The scheme is proposed to be included in the Fifth Five Year Plan.
