Restrictions have also been imposed on inter-State movement of khandsari, bura etc.

## **DEVELOTMENT OF TCURISM IN ORISSA**

402. SHRI B. C. PATTANAYAK : Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state :

(a) the steps taken during the last three years for development of tourism in Oiissa;

(b) whether the desirability of opening some good hotels in any of the places of tourist attraction in Orissa has been considered: and

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (DR. KARAN SINGH): (a) For promoting tourist traffic to Orissa a folder on Puri-Bhubaneshwar-Konark in English, French, German, Spanish and Italian, an insert on Orissa containing factual information and a poster on Puri Rath Yatra were produced and widely distributed. In addition, places of tourist interest were included in the Eastern Region folder which was also produced for overseas circulation in English, French, German, Spanish and Italian languages. The Department of Tourism is also negotiating the purchase of a film on Odissi dance for screening in India and abroad.

(b) and (c) The Department of Tourism does not construct hotels. The India Tourism Development Corporation, a public sector undenaking, proposes to take up the expansion of their Travellers Lodge in Bhubaneshwar during the Fourth Plan. The De a tment of Tourism has also approved a 75-room hotel project in Bhubaneshwar in the private sector.
