- (b) The following steps are being taken to check thefts of equipments:
- 1. To the extent possible Railway Protection Force staff are deployed round the clock for the protection of railway property and equipments against thefts. In addition two Battalions of Armed Railway Protection Special Force have recently been deployed in West Bengal been deployed in West Bengal.
- 2. Important night trains are escorted by GRP/RPF personnel in affected sections.

3. Plain clothes staff of Railway Protection Force are utilised for collection of criminal intelligence with a view to tracking down criminals and receivers of stolen property.

4. On the request of Ministry of Railways, the Ministry of Home Affairs have drawn attention of the State Governments regarding the necessity of preventive action as the effective preventive action as also effective investigation and prosecution of cases of thefts of copper/ traction wire and signalling equipment.
