- (c) His Majesty the King of Nepal had visited New Delhi in June, 1971 The new Indo-Nepal Treaty of Trade and Fransit had, inter alia, figured during the talks
- (d) and (e) A delegation had left on the morning of Wednesday, the August 4, 1971 for Kathmandu to resume talks on a New Treaty of Trade and Transit It is the hope that the ensuing talks will result in settlement of the outstanding issues to the mutual satisfaction of India and Nepal.
