## BURNING OF A MUSLIM DEAD BODY IN MYSORE

(a) whether the attention of Government has been drawn to a report that appeared in a Kannada weekly 'Jaga-darshi' dated the 13th June, 1971, published from Mangalore to the effect that a dead body of a Muslim was forcibly burnt by some non-Muslims in the Hassan District of Mysore;

(b) if so, under what circumstances this incident took place; and

(c) the reaction of Central Government in the matter?

OF PERSONNEL/गृह मंत्रालय और कार्मिक विभाग में राज्य मंत्री (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRDHA) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) According to the information received from the State Government, a Muslim suffering from Leuco-derma died in Kenchamma Hoskote in Alur Taluk, Hassan District, and that the dead body was buried according to the Muslim religious custom. On account of superstitious belief that if the dead body of a person suffering from Leprosy was allowed to be buried it portended evil, a few Hindus in the village unauthorisedly exhumed the body and cremated it on 26th May, 1971. A case has been registered under section 297 of the Indian Penal Code and is being investigated according to law.
