(a) whether an "Employment Programme" envisaging jobs for 1000 people in each district was started in April, 1971;

(b) if so, the names of the States for which the schemes have been approved and started and when the schemes for the other remaining States are likely to be finalised;

(c) the estimated expenditure likely to be incurred on the programme; and

(d) the period likely to be taken in its execution?

(a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Schemes have been approved in 258 districts distributed over different States and Union Territories except Nagaland and Dadra & Nagar

Haveli for which proposals have not been received. Proposals for another 57 districts have been processed and sanctions are under issue; proposals for 20 districts are under examination; and proposals for the remaining 20 districts are awaited.

(c) and (d) The current year's estimate of expenditure is Rs. 50 crores. It is envisaged that the scheme will continue to be in operation during the remaining period of the Fourth Plan.

(1) PROF. SHER SINGH): (a) A statement giving the total number of Development Blocks State-wise is appended.

(b) The staffing pattern for a Block approved by the Ministry some time back provided for a Block Development Officer, 9 Extension Officers, 10 Gram Savaks 2 Gram Sevikas and a supporting staff of about 20 including staff at primary health centre and veterinary dispensary. The pattern provided for an expenditure of Rs. 3.83 lakhs on staff (including pre-existing staff in a Block) and expenditure on contingencies over a period of five years. This works out to an average expenditure of Rs. 64,680 per annum on staff and Rs.
