As a result of this inspection the staff strength of the India Supply Mission, London was reduced from 200 to 185 and of India Supply Mission, Washington from 111 to 104. The staff strength of the India Supply Mission, London has been further reduced to 169, and that of India Supply Mission, Washington will be reduced to 101 shortly.

(SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN): (a) and (b) The Kiriburu Mines are being expanded and developed by the National Mineral Development Corporation to meet the requirements of Bokaro for iron ore. Supplies from the Kiriburu Expansion Scheme which is planned to meet the full requirements of Bokaro for lump ore and fines will not be available before the end of 1974. Alternative sources of supply are being tapped for a part of the requirements in 1972 to 1974. It has already been ascertained that these requirements can be met from Bolani and Noamandi in the Barajamda area and the question of making necessary arrangements for transport has been taken up with the Railways.

The requirements for manganese ore will be met by the Minerals and Metals Trading Corporation from sources of supply in Orissa.

(SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN): (a) and (b). There has been shortage of coal and rise in its prices in some parts of the country especially northern India.

(c) and (d) This is mainly due to the non-availability of adequate number of wagons for the movement of coal, which in turn is due to the large-scale thefts of wagon parts, over-head wire, signalling and other railway equipment and assaults on railway staff in the Bengal-Bihar areas as a result of the deteriorating law and order situation there. The Government of India is fully aware of the position and is taking steps in consultation with the State Government to improve the law and order situation and restore normalcy in the railway operations.
