STATEMENT

Eighty-five per cent of the land has been acquired About half of the dredging work has been completed The oil jetty was commissioned in August 1968. The construction of the Dock system is in progress The ore and coal loading plants for installation in the Dock for mechanical handling of ore and coal are being fabricated by the Mining and Allied Machinery Corporation Durgapur. Seven 650 H P Broad Gauge Locomotives have already been purchased from Chuttaranjan Locomotive Works Orders for transporter cranes and container cranes have been placed. As regards erection of various electrical equipment and accessories work is in progress Four Dock tugs and one tug-cum-fire float are being manufactured by Garden Reach Work-shops Ltd., Calcutta A contract for the construction of an estuarian dredger has been awarded to Garden Reach Workshops Ltd, Calcutta and is intended to do intensive dredging in the channel between Haldia and the sea to enable deep-drafted vessels to come to Haldia Road and temporary railway connec-

tions to worksites and important points are mostly completed Construction of residential quarters, work of drainage, water supply etc are in progress
