(a) whether it is a fact that there is only one unit in the private sector in the country which manufactures Carburators required for Cars;

(b) whether it is also a fact that on account of this a monopoly has been created resulting in the high price of Carburators to the extent of Rs. 350 each;

(c) whether Government propose to issue licences to few entrepreneurs for the manufacture of Carburators; and

(d) the reasons for not giving incentives to small units for the manufacture of this item when there is abundant scope for their development?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT/**ATELLIAN GAMENTIAL OZA**): (a) At present there is only one firm in the small-scale sector which manufactures carburators for cars.

(b) Government are not aware of any high price being charged by this firm.

(c) One firm has teen licensed for an annual capacity of 60,000 nos. of carburators. In addition, letters of intent have 'been granted !to ten new entrants for establishment of new industrial undertakings and two existing units for expansion for a total annual capacity of 7,40,000 nos. of carburators.

(d) The presumption that incentives are not given to small-scale manufacturers of the item is not correct.

It will be inappropriate to disclose the names of the Chief Ministers.

In respect of none of these complaints enquiries were entrusted to the Central Bureau of Investigation. However, the Central Government have appointed a Commission under the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952 to enquire into certain allegation asainst certain former Ministers of Punjab including Chief Minister. A copy of the Notification appointing the Commission has already been laid on the Table of the Sabha.

The Commission appointed by the Central Government has recently started functioning and their report is awaited.
