योजना मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री

(श्री मोहन धारिया): (क) समाधानों की स्थिति के अध्ययन में विदिन हुआ है कि दिसम्बर, 1971 के अन्त तक विस्थापित-राहत के भार के कारण वित्तीय दृष्टि में योजना के आकार में कोई खाम परिवर्तन होने की सम्भावना नहीं।

(ख) योजना आयोग इस समय चौथी पंचवर्षीय योजना का मध्यावधि मूल्यांकन कर रहा है, उसमें विदिन हुआ है कि योजना के प्रथम दो वर्षों के दौरान कई क्षेत्रों के व्यय में कमी आई है। परन्तु वित्तीय समाधानों की कमी ने मुख्य बाधक की भूमिका नहीं निभाई। मध्यावधि मूल्यांकन जो कि राज्य सरकारों, केन्द्रीय मंत्रालयों और योजना आयोग का संयुक्त प्रयास है, अभी तैयार किया जा रहा है। अब तक की उपलब्धियों की आलोचनात्मक समीक्षा करने और भविष्य के लिए दृष्टिकोण का निर्धारण करने के लिए योजना आयोग में विचार-विमर्श हो रहे हैं। मध्यावधि मूल्यांकन शीघ्र ही पूरा होने वाला है।

योजना मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री SHRI MOHAN DHARIA) (a) A study of the resources position has indicated that even after taking into account the refugee relief burden up to the end of December 1971, the size of the plan in monetary terms may not undergo any substantial change

(b) The mid-term appraisal of the Fourth Five Year Plan the exercise on which the Planning Commission is currently engaged has shown that there are shortfalls in expenditure in several sectors in the first two years of the plan. However, lack of financial resources has not acted as a principal constraint. The mid-term appraisal which is the joint endeavour of the State Governments, the Central Ministries and the Planning Commission is still under way. Discussions are being held in the Planning Commission to critically review the achievements made so far and to assess the outlook for the future. The Mid-term Appraisal is likely to be completed soon.]

MOHSIN) a) and b) The provisional results of the 1971 Census of India have revealed that urban population forms 19.87 per cent of the total population. Though this proportion is low as compared to that of industrialised countries like U.K. (78.87), Canada (73.58), France

(69.97) etc. it is higher than that observed in neighbouring countries as Ceylon (18.87) or Pakistan (13.57)

[Figures in brackets indicate percentage of urban population to total population]

c) In a vast agricultural country like India urban areas cannot be expected to account for a very large proportion of the total population. No further investigation is the more considered necessary.
